The newest permanent resident of this waterfront community stands 40 feet tall and spreads out about 40 feet, as well. Its trunk is 27 inches in diameter. Weighing in at about 55,000 pounds, this exquisite live-oak started as a mere sapling in 1954 in Orangeburg, South Carolina, at the Shady Grove Plantation and Nursery.
